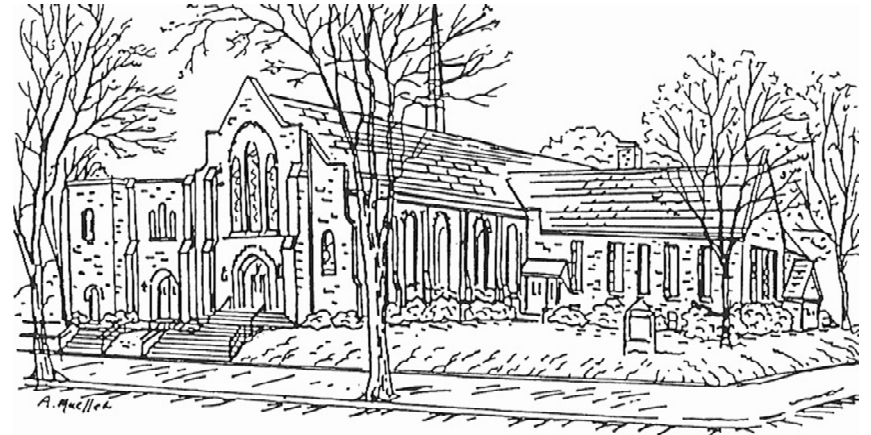
Third Sunday (March 20) suggested non-perishable food item is **Beans/dry or canned** and the hygiene item is **Razors/ Shaving cream.**
