Third Sunday (May 15) suggested non-perishable food item is **Canned Vegetables** and the hygiene item is **Bar soap**.

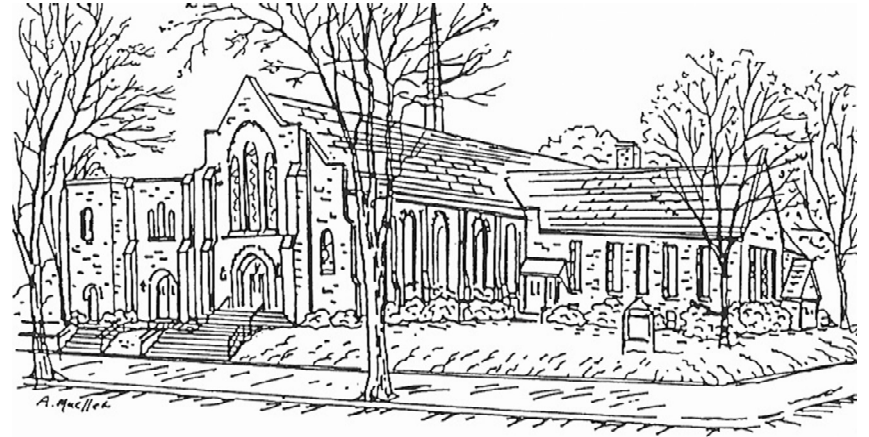
Please pray for the Pulpit Committee as they continue to discern the way forward for FBCWA.
